

## SUB-SESSION - 2

### Recovery of Public Sector Efficiency - Corruption, Bureaucracy and Governance of State-owned Enterprises.

#### Importance of the topic:

The development of policy documents and laws, any decision related to business and investment to be made by the State Great Khural (Parliament of Mongolia), the Government, and other public administration bodies have to be discussed by the public, the private sector, and all other stakeholders to reflect their point of views before the adoption and execution. Therefore, the session is set to conduct a discussion between the stakeholders for the effective implementation of the Recovery of the Public Sector Efficiency.

#### Purpose of the discussion:

The main objectives of the open session on "Recovery of the Public Sector Efficiency - Corruption, Bureaucracy and Governance of State-Owned Enterprises" are to digitalize government services to reduce government bureaucracy, conduct a comprehensive analysis of the structure and organization of the government to condition the most appropriate structure, and, if necessary, draft relevant laws for discussion to make amendments to the Constitution of Mongolia. It will aim to actively discuss bringing tenders, public-private partnerships to a new level, delegating functions of the government to the private sector and associations, streamlining the duplication of the government inspection system, temporarily suspending scheduled inspections, reducing the number of licenses and technical specifications required by government agencies. The session will also aim to improve the efficiency and governance of state-owned enterprises and bring the enterprises under direct public scrutiny, and exchange views on strengthening the penalties for corruption and official misconduct.

#### Expected outcome of the discussion:

Increased efficiency of the public sector, reduced bureaucracy, improved support for the private sector and civil society through expeditious services without delay and conflict of interest, and development of legal and digital environment.

### ALTAI KHANGAI

CEO, Mongolian Stock Exchange  
(MSE)

Mr. Altai Khangai re-appointed as the CEO of the MSE in September 2016. During his service, he has created the regulatory framework for introducing new products in the market, which enabled the introduction of the first securities dual-listing, first investment fund listing, and listed asset-backed securities in the market.

He is an active promoter of the capital markets to the investors community and potential issuers, as a result, the Mongolian capital market has been through an IPO boom since late 2017 and welcomed investments into the local capital market by well-known international institutional investors. Mongolian capital market has reached the market capitalization of USD2 billion in 2021 and the daily turnover reached USD2 million which is a 21-fold increase compared to the previous year.

Mr. Altai was initially appointed as the CEO of the MSE between 2011 and 2014, during which he led the Capital Market Development Programme implemented in partnership with the London Stock Exchange Group and brought reformative changes to the market including the revision of the Securities Markets Law and the market rules and regulations, installation of the state-of-the-art technology and reformation of the settlement system, that shapes Mongolian securities market today. During his time of service at the MSE, the market capitalization of Mongolian capital market jumped to USD 2.0 billion in 2011 from USD 400.00 million in 2009.

His previous work experiences include – Swiss based commodity trading house, Toronto based Centerra Gold Inc., the Personal Aide to the Mongolian Prime Minister and the Special Advisor to the Prime Minister. He is an Honorary President of Mongolian-British Chamber of Commerce and a founding partner of one of local real estate development companies. He also represented BBEnergy – one of the world's leading independent energy trading companies in Mongolia.
