SUB-SESSION - 3

Recovery of Ports - Transport and Logistics Crisis

Importance of the topic:

There is an increased need to realistically identify the current circumstances of the domestic and international transportation and logistics situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak. It is crucial to strengthen cooperation between the public and private sectors in the successful implementation of road and railway infrastructure projects to ensure the coordination of new transport infrastructure and increase the capacity of border crossings.

Purpose of the discussion:

The main objectives of the open session on "Recovery of Ports - Transportation and Logistics Crisis" are to determine the solutions to challenges in the transport and logistics sectors in the medium term, to involve the public and private sectors as well as foreign and domestic investors, and to develop an optimal solution that reflects the views of experts and other stakeholders in creating a harmonized transport and logistics network.

It also aims to develop a legal environment that supports private investments in the implementation of projects and programs aimed at improving transport and logistics capacity, increasing the efficiency of transport corridors to support regional social and economic development. The discussion will also aim to support the expansion of foreign and domestic tourism through the effective implementation of air transport sector liberalization and contribute to the recovery of the country's economy through inter-sectoral cooperation.

Expected outcome of the discussion:

It is expected to jointly identify the effective ways to implement sectoral policies of the transport and logistics sectors for further realization under the Public-Private Partnership schemes and to find the optimal solutions for the establishment of a legal and investment environment that encourages and supports the private sector engagement.

MUNKHSOYOL BAATARJAV

CEO, Institute of National Strategy

Ms. Munkhsoyol is the CEO of the Institute for National Strategy.
